This US law was passed in 1979 and brings together various international trade agreements and all contracts on the GSA Schedule (the General Services Administration's schedule to prenegotiated contracts) to promote fair and open international trade. TAA compliant products make it possible for U.S. government agencies and educational institutions to do business with a USA based company like G&D North America Inc.
